

THE TRUTH ABOUT GOD

INTRODUCTION:

About 2,000 years ago a baby was born to a woman named Mary. This baby was named Jesus. Jesus was no ordinary baby. Mary was a virgin and she gave birth to Jesus by the Holy Spirit. His birth was a miracle. Mary did not choose a name for her baby. His name came from heaven. Jesus' ministry and its effects on men adds proof to the claim that Jesus is God. Napoleon Bonaparte, a famous French conqueror, recognized Jesus was more than a man. He said, "I tell you, I know men. Jesus was more than a man. Charlemagne, Alexander, and I have founded empires, but on what have we founded them? On force! Jesus has founded an empire greater in territorial extent, and vaster in significance, on love. I have inspired men so that they would die for me, but fancy a man dying for me nearly twenty centuries after I am dead, and yet that's what men are doing, the world over, for this man, Jesus of Nazareth."

Jesus' ministry was one of compassion and love for lost men. Jesus, speaking of Himself, said, "For the Son of Man came to look for and to save from the punishment of sin those who are lost" (Luke 19:10 NLT). Jesus' ministry to the lost included many miracles. He caused the lame to walk, opened the ears of the deaf, made the blind to see, and brought the dead back to life. Being God, Jesus could do anything. Some men began to understand that Jesus was God. Jesus asked His followers, "Who do you say that I am?" (Matthew 16:15 NLT). Peter answered that He was the promised Savior, the Son of God. Jesus was happy that they understood who He was. Jesus told Peter that no man had taught him this. "My Father in heaven has shown you this" (Matthew 16:17 NLT). If you want to know who Jesus is, you need to ask God's Spirit to help you to understand. The Spirit will show you that Jesus was God come to earth as a man. He will show you through His Holy Writings and by speaking to your heart. The Holy Spirit which is the Spirit of Jesus will begin to minister to you, showing you the truth about Jesus. When you believe that Jesus is God, you will be happy. Thomas, a follower of Jesus, did not believe Jesus had come back to life after cruel men had killed Jesus. However, Jesus did come back to life and He showed Himself to Thomas. When Thomas saw Jesus, he said, "My Lord and my God! Jesus said to him, Thomas, because you have seen Me, you believe. Those are happy who have never seen Me and yet believe!" (John 20:28-29 NLT).

Men who did not believe Jesus was God killed Him. They thought that this would prove He was not God. But you cannot kill God. Jesus took His Spirit out of His body and allowed His body to die. Only Jesus' body bled and died. The blood that Jesus shed was shed for us that we might have life. After three days Jesus returned His Spirit to His body, came out of His grave and proved He was God. Jesus is still alive today. He has returned to heaven and sent His Spirit back to live in our lives if we will believe in Him.

CONCLUSION:

The Bible clearly says there is only one Lord or God. "The greatest law is this, 'Listen, Jewish People, The Lord our God is one Lord!' '(Mark 12:29 NLT).
