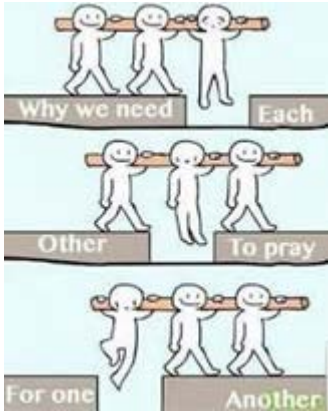


## I Need You, You Need Me
